

STOP WORK AUTHORITY POLICY

AT COLBÚN, WE ASPIRE TO BE A LEADING COMPANY IN THE ENERGY INDUSTRY AND WE PROMOTE A STRONG SAFETY CULTURE AS THE CORE OF OUR MANAGEMENT TO ACHIEVE OUR STRATEGY. THEREFORE, WE ARE COMMITTED TO ENSURING THAT THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF THE PEOPLE WHO PERFORM TASKS AT OUR FACILITIES ARE A PRIORITY IN ALL THE WORK WE CARRY OUT.

THIS POLICY IS COMMUNICATED TO OUR EMPLOYEES, CONTRACTORS AND DIRECTORS OF COLBÚN AND SUBSIDIARIES, THEREFORE, EVERYONE IN THE COMPANY HAS THE RESPONSIBILITY TO APPLY THE PRINCIPLES DESCRIBED BELOW.

GENERAL PRINCIPLES

- When a person (regardless of their hierarchical level) identifies an unsafe task, they have an obligation to immediately stop that work using the **Stop Work Authority Card**.
- The leader of the halted activity, together with the involved workers and the Occupational Health and Safety Area, must establish the necessary control measures to address the detected hazard and bring it to a controlled risk level.
- The leader of the halted activity may resume the work once the conditions that led to the use of the **Stop Work Authority Card** have been resolved and are at a controlled risk level.
- Individuals who make use of this measure must promote responsible and safe behaviors in the execution of tasks. The use of the **Stop Work Authority Card** assumes a rational and prudent behavior from the person using it and there will be no punishment or consequences for those who apply it by mistake
